The elegant, sophisticated fabrics in the Black, White & Currant collection speak for themselves. This easy quilt showcases the fabric with a dramatic, pieced border. Please read the instructions before beginning. Seams are 1/4". wof = width of fabric.

**FABRIC IN THE BLACK, WHITE & CURRANT COLLECTION**

- 7058 - Botanical - /4 White, /99 Black, /88 Currant
- 7059 - Petals - /88 Currant, /99 Black
- 7060 - Stripe - /88 Currant, /4 White, /99 Black
- 7061 - Swirling Floral - /4 White, /99 Black, /88 Currant
- 7062 - Flower Medallions - /88 Currant, /4 White, /99 Black, /48 White Currant
- 7063 - Damask - /98 Currant Black, /99 Grey Black

**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

Assorted Black, White & Current Fabrics	For maximum impact, use 8 or more fat quarters or 1/4 yd cuts (Minimum yardage needed is 1 5/8 yd.)
Currant Botanical 7058-88	1 1/4 yard (block corners, outer border & binding)
Current Flower Medallions 7062-88	1/2 yd inner borders
White Flower Medallions 7062-4	1/2 yd inner border
Grey Black Damask 7063-99	7/8 yd inner border
Backing	3 1/2 yd

**CUTTING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE BLOCKS**

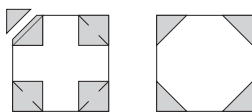
- From Assorted Black, White & Currant Fabrics:
- (64) 5" squares
- From Currant Botanical 7058-88
- (12) 1 3/8" x wof strips subcut into (256) 1 5/8" squares

**CUTTING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE BORDERS**

- Current Flower Medallions 7062-88
- (12) 1 1/2" x wof strips pieced into (8) 1 1/2" x 56" strips
- White Flower Medallions 7062-4
- (6) 2 1/2" strips pieced into (4) 2 1/2" x 56" strips
- Grey Black Damask 7063-99
- (6) 4" strips x wof strips pieced into (4) 4" x 56" strips
- Current Botanical 7058-88
- (6) 1 1/2" x wof strips pieced into (4) 1 1/2" x 56" strips
- Binding
- (6) 2 1/2" x wof strips, pieced together end to end.

**SNOWBALL BLOCK**

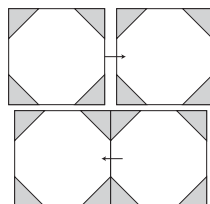
Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side (or finger press) the 1 5/8" squares of currant botanical fabric. Place a square, right sides together, on a corner of a 5" square. Sew on the line and trim the corner away. Press. Repeat with the remaining three corners of the square.



Make 64.

**CONSTRUCTION**

Arrange the squares in a pleasing arrangement. Use a design wall if you have one. Sew the squares together into sixteen four-patch units. Sew these units together to complete the quilt top.



**BORDERS**

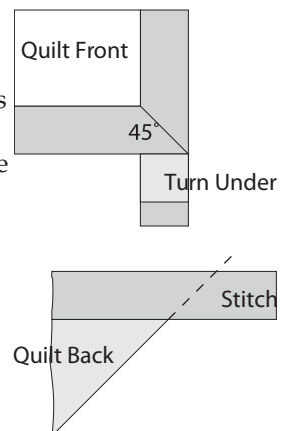
The borders are mitered. Sew all the border strips together lengthwise before sewing to the quilt. Make four 56" strip sets in this order:

1. 1 1/2" Current Flower Medallions 7062-88
2. 2 1/2" White Flower Medallions 7062-4
3. 1 1/2" Current Flower Medallions 7062-88
4. 4" Grey/Black Damask 7063-99
5. 1 1/2" Currant Botanical 7058-88

These sets will measure 9 1/2" x 56". Find the center point each side of the quilt top. Match to the center point of a border strip set. With wrong sides together, pin to the sides of the quilt.

Start and stop stitching 1/4" from the each end, backstitch to secure your seams. The extra length will extend beyond the quilt top. Press seams toward the borders. Repeat to sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt top. Press toward the borders.

To miter the corners, place a corner face up on a pressing surface. Extend the ends of the borders. Fold under the border on top at a 45° angle. Press. Use a ruler to be check your 45° angle. Fold the quilt right sides together and pin the border along the fold line. This is your stitching guide. Trim excess and press. Repeat with the remaining corners.



Bind the quilt with 2 1/2" strips of Currant Botanical 7058-88.
