Skill level: Intermediate • Finished Quilt Size: 34" x 34" • Block Count & Size: 16 Ohio Star blocks, 6" x 6"

Fabric A* 1/8 yard	560-4	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (4) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on the diagonal twice to make (16) quarter square triangles	Fabric K 1/8 yard	564-7	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (9) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (36) quarter square triangles. Trim remainder to 2-1/2" them cut (3) 2-1/2" squares.
Fabric B 1/8 yard	560-7	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (4) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (16) quarter square triangles. Trim remainder of strip to 2-1/2" wide then cut (3) 2-1/2" squares	Fabric L 1/8 yard	565-4	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (2) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (8) quarter square triangles.
Fabric C 1/8 yard	561-3	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (4) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (16) quarter square triangles	Fabric M 1/4 yard	565-21	Cut (2) 2-1/2" x wof strips; recut into (21) 2-1/2" squares
Fabric D 1/8 yard	561-7	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (3) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (12) quarter square triangles.	Fabric N 1/8 yard	566-7	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (5) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (20) quarter square triangles.
Fabric E 1/8 yard	561-10	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (2) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (8) quarter square triangles.	Fabric O 1/8 yard	566-10	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (3) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (12) quarter square triangles.
Fabric F 1/8 yard	562-7	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (2) 2-7/8" squares, then cut the squares in half on diagonal twice to make (8) quarter square triangles. Trim remainder of strip to 2-1/2" then cut (4) 2-1/2" squares.	Fabric P 1/4 yard	567-8	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (3) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (12) quarter square triangles. Cut (1) 2-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (16) 2-1/2" squares
Fabric G 1/8 yard	562-8	Cut (1) 2-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (16) 2-1/2" squares	Fabric Q 1/8 yard	567-10	Cut (1) 2-1/2" square
Fabric H 1/8 yard	563-4	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (1) 2-7/8" squares, then cut the square in half on diagonal twice to make (4) quarter square triangles.	Fabric R** 1/8 yard	568-7	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (12) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (48) quarter square triangles.
Fabric I 1/8 yard	563-7	Cut (1) 2-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (6) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (24) quarter square triangles. From remainder of strip cut (1) 2-1/2" square.	Fabric S 1/8 yard	568-10	Cut (1) 2-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (6) 2-1/2" squares
Fabric J 1/4 yard	563-10	Cut (2) 2-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (2) 2-1/2" x 34-1/2" strips for top/bottom borders	Fabric T 1/2 yard	569-7	Cut (5) 2-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (5) 2-1/2" x 30-1/2" vertical sashes Cut (2) 2-7/8" x wof strips; recut into (17) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (68) quarter square triangles.
			Fabric U 1/8 yard	569-10	Cut (2) 2-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (24) 2-1/2" squares
			*Backing 1-1/8 yard	560-7	Trim to 40" x 40" for backing
			**Binding 1/3 yard	568-7	Cut (4) 2-1/4" x wof strips and sew together end-to-end

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Making the Quilt

1. Refer to diagrams 1 and 2 sew the blocks together. Diagram 1 shows the block assembly and diagram 2 shows fabric placement for each block. Begin by sewing the quarter square triangles into 4 identical hourglass units for each block. Using the 2-1/2” squares, sew the units and squares into rows, then sew the rows together to complete the block. Make 20 blocks arranging the fabrics as indicated on the block diagrams.
2. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram to sew the blocks together into (4) vertical rows. Each vertical row has (5) blocks. Place the blocks as indicated in the quilt assembly diagram or in an arrangement of your own choosing.
3. Sew the vertical rows together, separating the (4) rows of blocks with a 2-1/2” x 30-1/2” fabric U sash strip. Begin and end with a sash strip.
4. Sew the fabric J 2-1/2” x 34-1/2” borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.
5. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Baste, then quilt the layers together.
6. Bind the outside edges to complete the quilt.

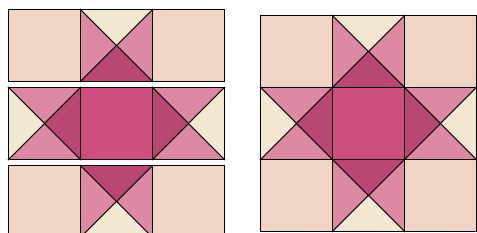
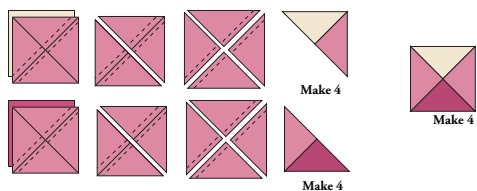


Diagram 1

Ohio Star Block

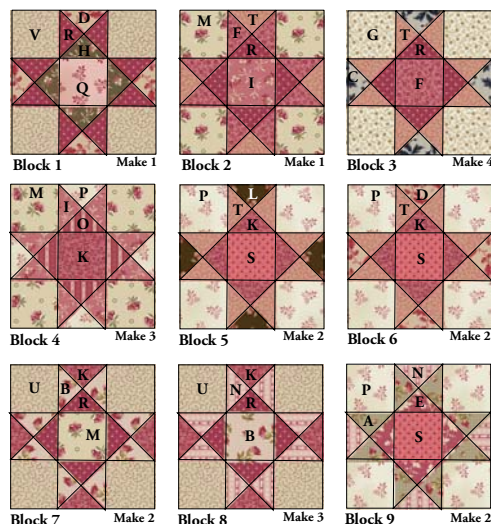
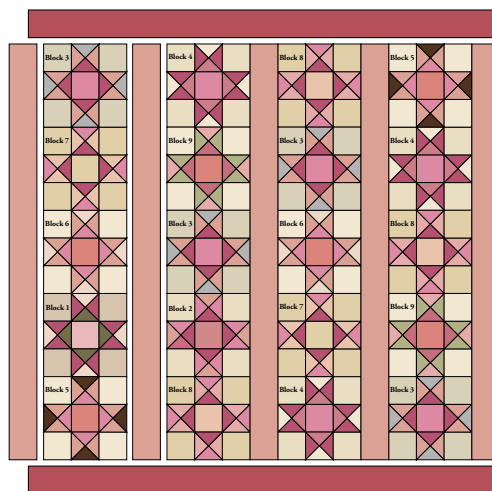


Diagram 2
