| • Eighteen 3-3/4" squares. Cut each square on one diagonal. | |
| Cut six 4-1/2" x 42" strips to yield | |
| • Seventy-two Template B triangles | |
| • Seventy-two Template C triangles | |
| Cut six 1-1/2" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make | |
| • Two 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips | |
| • Two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips | |
| Cut five 2-1/2" x 42" strips for the binding | |

| Cut six 3-1/8" x 42" strips to yield | |

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew one 2-1/4" black triangle to each side of 2-1/2" Wild Style square. Sew one 2-1/4" black triangle to the top and bottom of the 2-1/2" Wild Style square (Fig. 1) to make one small block center.
2. Sew one 3-1/8" aged muslin triangle to each side of the small block center. Sew one 3-1/8" aged muslin triangle to the top and bottom of the small block center to make one corner block (Fig. 2). Trim the corner block to measure 4-1/2" square.
3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make four 4-1/2" corner blocks of each animal print for a total of thirty-six corner blocks.
4. Sew one 3-3/4" black triangle to each side of 4-1/2" Wild Style square. Sew one 3-3/4" black triangle to the top and bottom of the 4-1/2" Wild Style square (Fig. 1) to make one large block center.
5. Sew one 5-1/8" matching Wild Style triangle to each side of the large block center. Sew one 5-1/8" matching Wild Style triangle to the top and bottom of the large block center (Fig. 2) to make one center block. Trim the center block to measure 8-1/2" square.
6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5 to make one 8-1/2" center block of each animal print for a total of nine center blocks.
7. Sew one Black Template B piece on the left side one Wild Style Template A piece (Fig 3). Press. Sew one Black Template C piece on the right side of the Wild Style Template A piece to make one 4-1/2" side unit (Fig. 4).
8. Repeat Step 7 with the remaining Black Template B and C pieces and Wild Style Template A pieces to make eight of each Wild Style side units for a total of seventy-two 4-1/2" side units.
9. Match up two side units and sew them together to make one 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" Diamond unit (Fig. 5). Make four 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" diamond units from each Wild Style to make a total of thirty-six diamond units.
10. Refer to the quilt photo for the Wild Style placement and follow the block layout to sew together nine 16-1/2" Wild Style Blocks.

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

11. Refer to the quilt photo for fabric and block placement to sew together three 16-1/2" Blocks to make one block row. Repeat to make three block rows.
12. Sew the rows together to make one 48-1/2" square quilt top.
13. Sew one 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" Black Strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" black strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

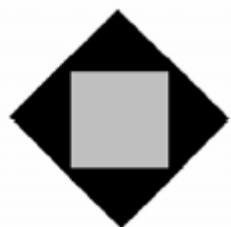

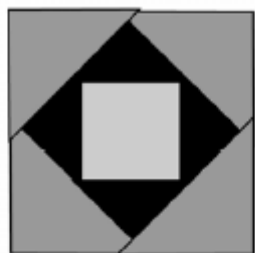

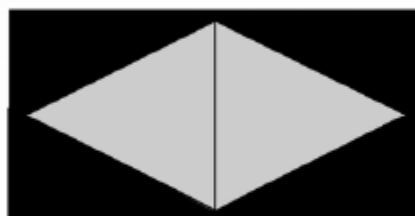

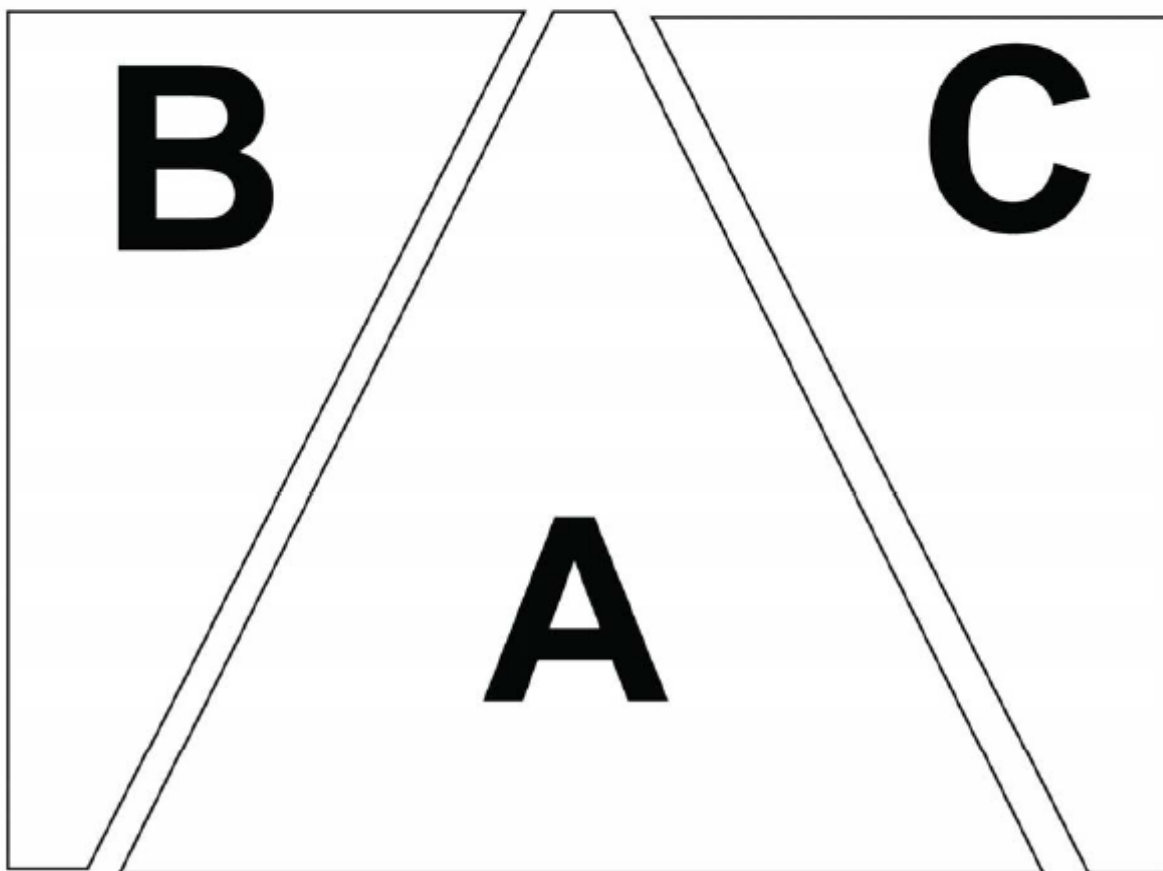
