CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: *Cut fabrics in order given.*

A. Pattern #17503 – CRE1 (toile):

1. Cut two 8½" x 42" strips for Border 2 (top and bottom).
2. Cut two 8½" x length of fabric strips (at least 28" long) for Border 2 (sides).

B. Pattern #17504 – MUL1 (wide border stripe):

1. Fussy cut three 8" x 42" strips for Outer Border (top and bottom).
2. Fussy cut two 8" x length of fabric strips (at least 58" long) for Outer Border (sides).

C. Pattern #17505 – BLU1 (blue rose toss):

1. Cut one 4⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4⅞" squares (Border 3).

D. Pattern #17505 – PIN1 (pink rose toss):

1. Cut one 4⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4⅞" squares (Border 3).

E. Pattern #17506 – PEA1 (narrow stripe):

1. Cut six 2" x 42" strips (Border 4).
2. Cut four 2¾" x length of fabric strips (at least 38" long) for corner blocks in Outer Border. Label strips X.

F. Pattern #17506 – BLU1 (narrow stripe):

1. Cut six 2" x 42" strips (Border 4).
2. Cut four 2" x length of fabric strips (at least 38" long) for corner blocks in Outer Border. Label strips Y.
3. From the remainder of the 38" length of fabric, cut nine 2½" crosswise strips (cutting across the stripes). Reserve for Binding.

G. Pattern #17507 – CRE1 (mini tone-on-tone):

1. Cut one 2½" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2½" squares (G) for the center block.

H. Pattern #17507 – MUS1 (mini tone-on-tone):

1. Cut one 2½" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 2½" squares (I) for the center block.

I. Pattern #17507 – GRE1 (mini tone-on-tone):

1. Cut two 2½" x 42" strips. Crosscut twenty 2½" squares (B) for the center block.

J. Pattern #17507 – RED1 (mini tone-on-tone):

1. Cut one 2½" x 42" strip. Crosscut twelve 2½" squares (C) for the center block.

K. Pattern #17507 – WIN1 (mini tone-on-tone):

1. Cut two 2½" x 42" strips. Crosscut twenty-one 2½" squares (F) for the center block.

L. Pattern #17507 – DKGRE1 (mini tone-on-tone):

1. Cut two 2½" x 42" strips. Crosscut twenty 2½" squares (E) for the center block.

M. Pattern #17508 – TAN1 (flower tone-on-tone):

1. Cut one 4⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4⅞" squares for Border 3.

N. Pattern #17508 – LTTUR1 (flower tone-on-tone):

1. Cut one 4⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4⅞" squares for Border 3.

O. Pattern #17508 – GRE1 (flower tone-on-tone):

1. Cut one 4⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4⅞" squares for Border 3.
2. Trim the width of the remainder of the 4⅞" strip to 4½" wide. Crosscut four 4½" squares for the corner blocks for Border 3.

P. Pattern #17508 – PEA1 (flower tone-on-tone):

1. Cut one 4⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 4⅞" squares for Border 3.

Q. Pattern #17509 – PEA1 (circles):

1. Cut one 4⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4⅞" squares for Border 3.

R. Pattern #17509 – GRE1 (circles):

1. Cut one 4⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4⅞" squares for Border 3.

S. Pattern #17509 – BRO1 (circles):

1. Cut one 4⅞" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 4⅞" squares for Border 3.

T. Pattern #17510 – RED1 (small floral):

1. Cut one 2½" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 2½" squares (A) for the center block.

U. Pattern #17510 – BLU1 (small floral):

1. Cut one 2½" x 42" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2½" squares (D) for the center block.
2. Cut four 1½" x 42" strips for Border 1.

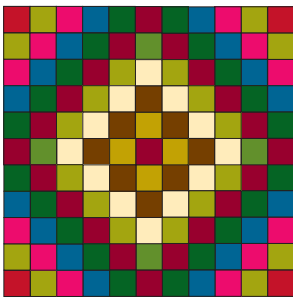
V. Pattern #17510 – GRE1 (small floral):

1. Cut one 2½" x 42" strip. Crosscut four 2½" squares (J) for the center block.

W. Pattern #17510 – BRO1 (small floral):

1. Cut one 2½" x 42" strip. Crosscut eight 2½" squares (H) for the center block.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS: Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.



Finished size of the center block: 22" square.

A. Center Block

- Referring to the diagrams for each row, sew the designated $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together in the order shown. Press seams for each row in the direction of arrows. Make four strips for each row.

Row 1:		Make four.
Row 2:		Make four.
Row 3:		Make four.
Row 4:		Make four.
Row 5:		Make four.
- Sew one strip each of Rows 1-5 together as shown in Figure 1 to make one quadrant of the center block. Make four identical quadrants. Press seams in each quadrant toward Row 1.

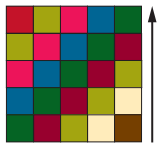

- Center strips: Make four. Press toward I in each strip.

Center Strip: Make four.

- Arrange the four quadrants, the center strips and the remaining F square as shown in Figure 2. Sew the units together. Press.

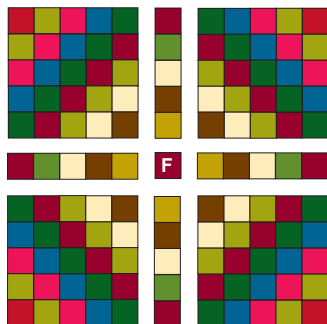

B. Half-Square Triangle Units:



- Constructing the half-square triangle units:
 - Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the $4\frac{7}{8}$ " light colored squares.
 - Pair a light colored square with a darker colored square, right sides together. [Tip: Pair four lighter peach squares with the four darker peach squares, the remaining four lighter peach squares with the four pink squares, the four turquoise with the four blue, the four lighter green with the four darker green, and the four tan with the four brown.]

- Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the diagonal line.
- Cut on the diagonal line to release two units. Press toward the darker triangles. Trim the dog ears. Yield: forty half-square triangle units.

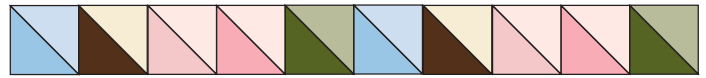


Figure 3 Make two.

- Arrange a variety of ten half-square triangle units as shown in Figure 3. Sew the units together. Press. Make two. Reserve for the top and bottom Border 3 strips.

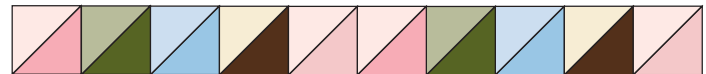
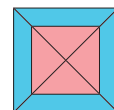


Figure 4 Make two.

- Arrange a variety of ten half-square triangle units as shown in Figure 4. Sew the units together. Press. Make two. Reserve for the side Border 3 strips.

C. Corner Block (for the Outer Border):

- Sew a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " pink X strip to a 2" blue Y strip. Press seam open. Make four.
- Using Template A, cut out four triangles from each strip set, with the blue stripe positioned at the base of each triangle (Figure 5).

Finished size: $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ "
Make four.

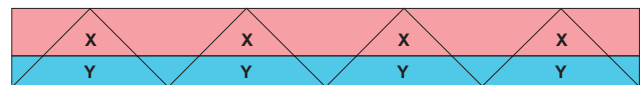
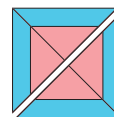

- Sew triangles together to complete the corner blocks (Figure 6). Press. Make four.

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to quilt diagram on the next page.

- Arrange all of the parts for the quilt on a design wall. [Tip: Be aware of the direction of the one-way designs of Border 2 and the Outer Border, and the positioning of the strips for Border 3.]
- Border 1:
 - Measure the length of the center block. Cut two Border 1 strips equal to that measurement. Sew to the sides of the center block. Press toward the border strips.
 - Measure the width of the center block unit. Cut the two remaining Border 1 strips equal to that measurement. Sew to the top and bottom of the center block unit. Press toward the border strips.
- Border 2:
 - Follow the directions for Border 1 to attach the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28" strips to the sides of the center unit for Border 2. Press toward Border 2.
 - Follow the directions for Border 1 to attach the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips to the top and bottom of the center unit for Border 2. Press toward Border 2.

4. Border 3:

- a. Sew the reserved side strips for Border 3 to the sides of the quilt. Press toward Border 2.
- b. Sew a 4½" green square to each end of the top and bottom Border 3 strips. Press toward the squares. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt, matching seams. Press toward Border 2.

5. Border 4:

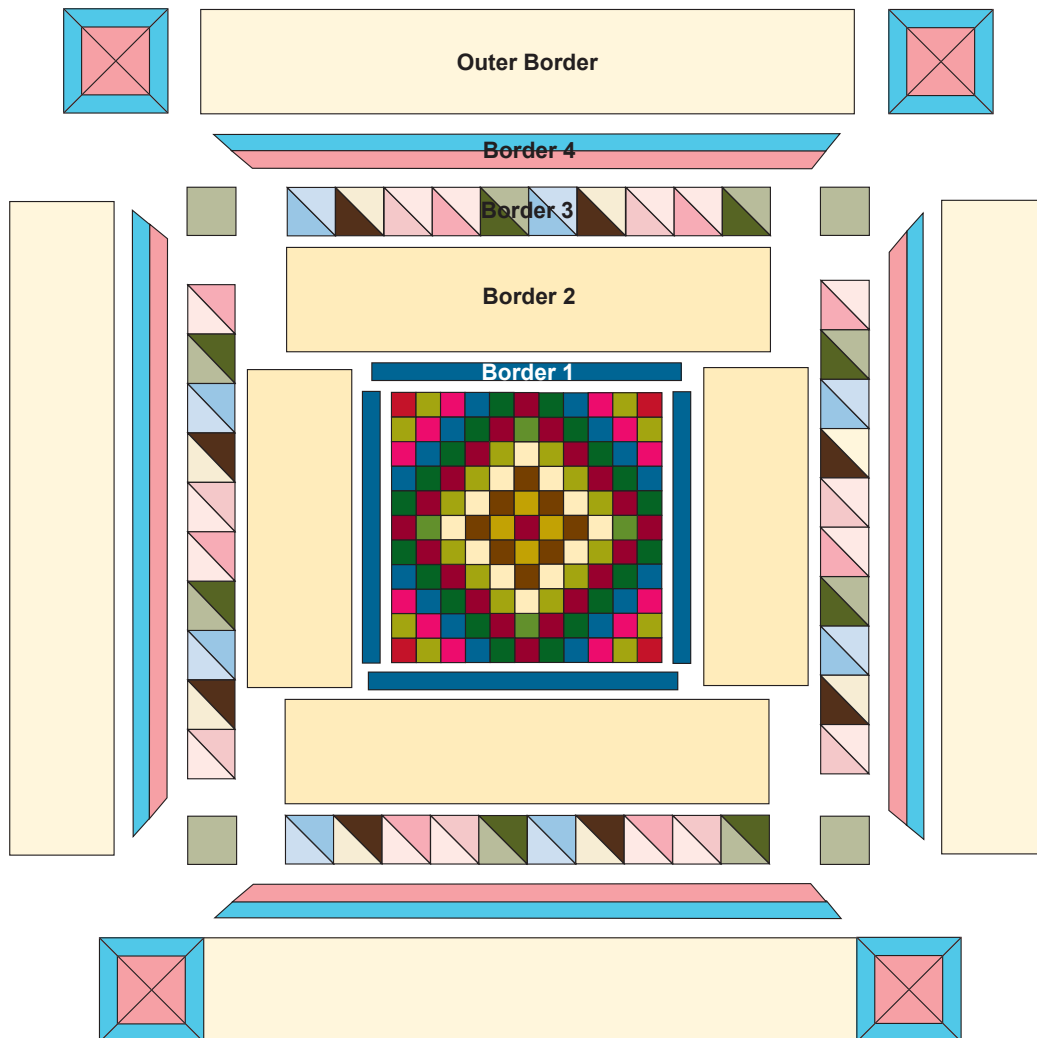
- a. Sew the six 2" pink strips together, end to end. Press seams open. Cut into four equal lengths, approximately 60" each.
- b. Sew the six 2" blue strips together, end to end. Press seams open. Cut into four equal lengths, approximately 60" each.
- c. Sew a 60" pink strip to a 60" blue strip. Press. Repeat to make four pink/blue strip sets.
- d. Match the center of the pink side of each strip set to the center of each side of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt, stitching to within ¼" of each corner of the quilt. Miter the corners. Trim excess at the corners. Press toward Border 4.

6. Outer Border:

- a. Sew the three 8" x 42" strips together, end to end. Press seams open. Cut two lengths equal to the width of the quilt. Sew a corner block to the ends of each strip. Press toward the border strips. Set aside for the top and bottom borders.
- b. Following the directions for Border 1, sew the 8" x 58" strips to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the outer border strips.
- c. Sew the top and bottom border strips to the quilt, matching seams. Press toward the outer border.

FINISHING:

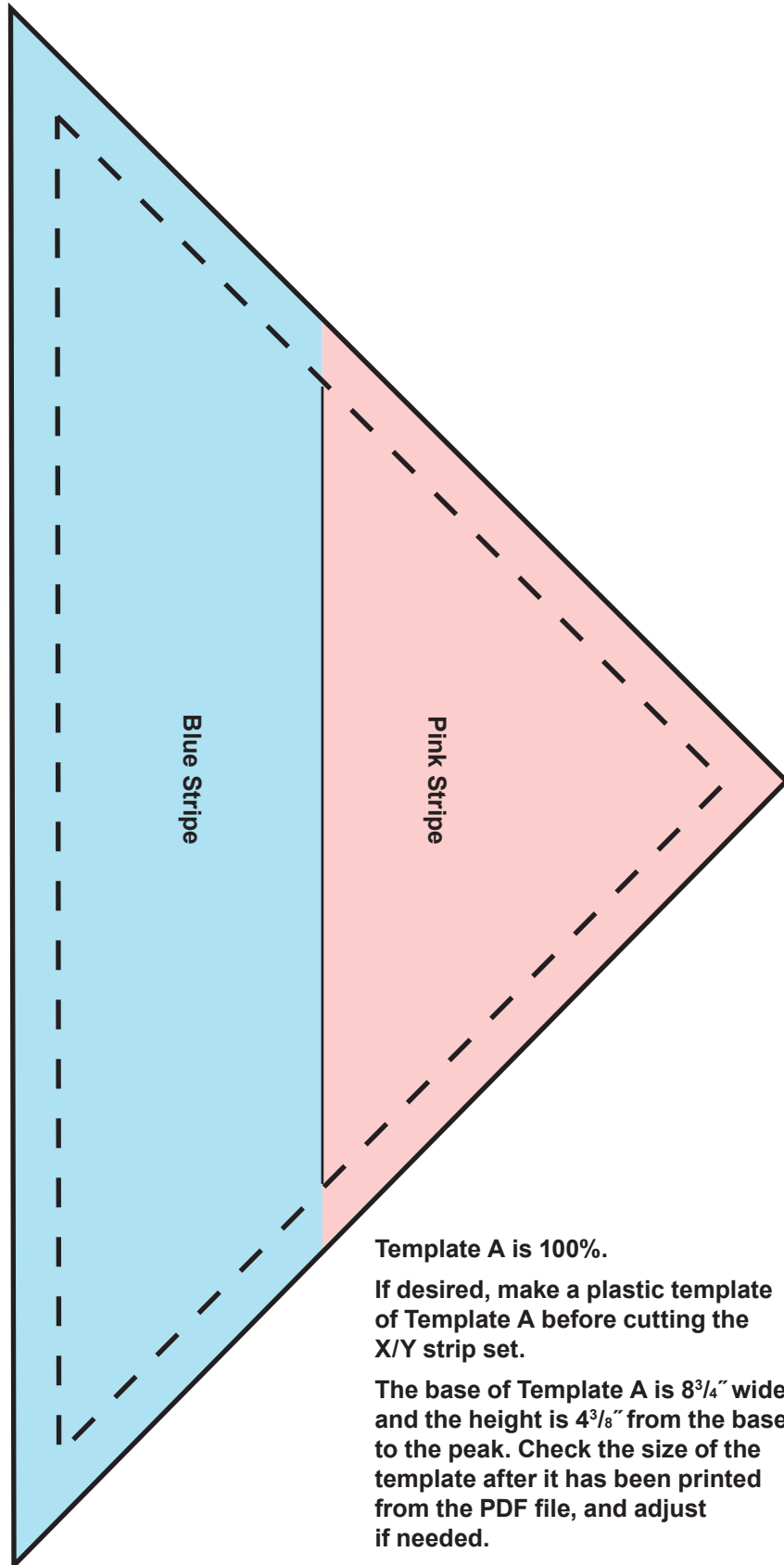
- 1. Prepare the backing with vertical seams to measure 75" x 75". Press seams open.
- 2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim the batting and backing even with the quilt top.
- 5. Join binding strips with straight seams, matching the stripes. Apply binding using your favorite method.



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Template A is 100%.

If desired, make a plastic template of Template A before cutting the X/Y strip set.

The base of Template A is $8\frac{3}{4}$ " wide and the height is $4\frac{3}{8}$ " from the base to the peak. Check the size of the template after it has been printed from the PDF file, and adjust if needed.
